Cable-Shift Cable Length Measurement Type I

Measure cable lengths from center of shifter handle position to dimple in transaxle shift rod. Measurement is taken along the running length.

The best way to measure is to:

- 1. Have a helper hold the body of the tape measure at the nose cone end of the transaxle.
- 2. Feed the end of the tape over the driver side axle tube, under the starter and along the driver side of engine sump.
- 3. Proceed with the tape (over or under the fuel tank if necessary) to a point between and ahead of the seats where the centerline of the shift handle will be.
- 4. Read the tape (in total inches) at the center of the dimple in the transaxle shift rod.

Note: This measurement will determine both cable lengths.
